





A LANDMARK

Twenty years ago, David Engwicht began transforming his entire yard into a public park, which today is known as *Civosity Park*.

The columns at the front have become a well-known landmark

It took David two years to make the original, then cast them in concrete.

The mold has since been destroyed, so these are the only ones that will ever exist.

The front of the house is to be remodeled, so these one-of-a-kind columns are now for sale.





HAND CAST


Each column was hand cast in concrete and allowed to cure in the mold for around six weeks.

Because the columns were hand cast, there are small 'imperfections' that make each one unique. There is also the tell-tale signs of having lived in a very popular park.


The columns were originally acid-stained to give them a stone-like look. They have recently been restored with a fresh acid-staining and a protective coating applied.
